- <sup>9</sup> The Lord has heard my supplication; the Lord accepts my prayer.


# <sup>10</sup> All my enemies shall be ashamed and struck with terror; they shall turn back and in a moment be put to shame.



#### **CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS**

Hear the words of challenge and comfort our Savior Christ says to all who follow him.
